OH&S ON THE WEB

The Sunshine State has put the spotlight on safety with a new web-based OH&S system set to not only make public hospitals a safer place to work but to also slash red tape.

The system – developed by Queensland company, Worksafe Management Systems – is built on a Microsoft.Net web platform.

CEO Bob Johnson said the new state-of-the-art IMS.Net system was the first fully web-based OH&S system to be used in Australia's public hospital system. It not only made the working environment safer, but also eliminated complex paperwork and allows risks and incidents to be logged in real-time, directly into the system.
